- 4. Spend quality time** with your child engaging him / her in activities based on enhancing his / her powers of observation and imagination.
- 5. Encourage your child to play** board games e.g. Chess, Ludo, Carrom etc.



Plants from Garbage

Stop! Don't throw that away!
You can grow plants from vegetable scraps.



Carrot Tops

When your family makes soup or salad, don't throw away the carrot tops. Instead, grow a plant.

What you need:

- A low bowl
- Some little stones
- Four carrots
- A knife
- Water

What to do:

1. Fill the low bowl half full with small, clean stones.
2. Cover the stones with water.
3. Cut the top inch off the four carrots. Ask a grown-up to help.
4. Set the carrot tops on the stones.
5. Make sure the water is always touching the carrot tops.
6. Set the bowl where it gets light.

In a few days, you will see green tops growing.

Potato Eyes

Don't throw away the "eyes" of uncooked potatoes. Eyes are the places where small buds grow out of old potatoes.

What you need:

- A pot or cup
- A potato with eyes
- A knife
- Dirt
- Water

What to do:

1. Ask a grown-up to cut a one-inch square piece around the eye of the potato.
2. Put some dirt in the pot or cup and add a little water.
3. Set the eye of the potato on the dirt in the pot.
4. Cover the potato with about two inches of dirt.
5. Put the pot near a window.
6. The plant needs water every few days.

Soon a bit of green plant will poke through the dirt.

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
